Class Definitions as defined by WNEPHA for 2018 Show Season:

BABY GREEN - Open to any horse in their first or second year of showing who has never shown higher than 2'6" in said 1st or 2nd year. Horses that enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at that show in which fence heights exceed 2'6". No rider restrictions. Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

LOW HUNTER - Open to all horses and ponies and riders with no age limitations. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

JUNIOR/AMATEUR HUNTER - Open to all except professional riders. No horse restrictions. Horse/rider combinations that enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at the show in which fence height exceeds 2'6". No combinations.

NOVICE HUNTER- Open to any rider who is eligible for novice adult or novice junior equitation as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders who enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at that show in which fence height exceeds 2'6". The course will not include any combinations. Fences not to exceed 2'0".

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY - Open to all ponies ridden by juniors. Small ponies, 12.2 hands and under to jump 2'. Medium ponies, 12.2 but not exceeding 13.2 to jump 2'3". Large ponies, over 13.2 but not to exceed 14.2 to jump 2'6". Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. NOTE: Children's Hunter may be run together as long as riders designate horse or pony. **CHILDREN'S**

HUNTER HORSE - Open to horses to be shown by junior riders. Riders over 15 years of age must still be eligible for Limit equitation over fences (i.e... they have not won 6 equitation blues over fences) as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences not to exceed 3' for horses. Note: if 6 or more of each (horses and ponies) are entered in this class, it should be split. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

PLEASURE DIVISION - May include Open Pleasure, Road Hack, Bridle Path Hack, Hunter Pleasure. Classes must be open to all horses and ponies. To be shown on the flat only at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Martingales not permitted.

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION - Open to riders 12 and under, who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in a recognized show, except riders may show in equitation classes where fence height does not exceed 2'. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 18". No combinations. Simple changes will not be penalized

LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION- Open to riders 13 and older (including amateur adults), who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in a recognized show, **except riders may show in equitation classes where fence height does not exceed 2'**. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 18". No combinations. Simple changes will not be penalized.

PRE-CHILDREN'S EQUITATION- Open to riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'3 in a recognized show, **except riders may show in equitation classes where**

fence height does not exceed 2'6". Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'0. No combinations. Simple changes will not be penalized.

CHILDREN'S EQUITATION- Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'6 in a recognized show, **except riders may show in equitation classes where fence height does not exceed 2'9" or jumper classes to .80 meters maximum.** Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'6 with at least one change of direction. No combinations.

MODIFIED JUNIOR EQUITATION- Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 3' in a recognized show. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'9 with at least one change of direction. Combinations are optional.

JUNIOR EQUITATION - Open to all junior riders who are not eligible for Pre Children's or Children's Equitation. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 3' with at least one change of direction. Combinations are optional.

ADULT EQUITATION - Open to riders 18 years of age and over. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

LEADLINE- Open to beginner riders age 10 and under who have never shown off the lead line before. Riders may not enter any other division. To be eligible for year-end participation ribbon, riders must compete at two shows during the season. Show secretary must submit proof of participation. Rider need not be a member to be eligible for this award.

WALK TROT- Open to riders 12 and under who have never shown at the canter. Riders may not enter any other division. To be eligible for a year-end participation ribbon, riders must accumulate a minimum of 28 points throughout the season. Riders must be members of the WNEPHA.

Beginner Equitation: Open to riders of any age beyond the Walk Trot level looking to transition into Short/Long Stirrup Equitation. Canter may be individual or small group, at judge's discretion. One class in division should include a ground pole course, trotting not to be penalized. To be eligible for a year-end participation ribbon, riders must accumulate a minimum of 28 points throughout the season and adhere to the 3 barn rule. Riders must be members of the WNEPHA.

Hunter Pairs Class: Special Class offered this year as a Benefit for the PHA Scholarship in the Memory of Marie and Jerry Raucher:

Objective of ride is to see versatility of horse within tradition of hunt rides. First horse to jump first four obstacles with 2nd horse evenly paced behind. At 5th obstacle horses are to change places with one another, with emphasis on a smooth transition between horse positions. 2nd horse to now lead in jumping next 4 obstacles, with 1st horse following at an even pace. The last and final obstacle to be jumped simultaneously by both horses. Riders are welcome to dress in coordinating attire. Pairing similar sized and marked horses is encouraged though unmatched pairs will not be penalized. Individual horse and riders may pair with more than one partner though no team may compete more than once.

- Pre-Entries PREFERRED. Payment to be completed prior to end of show. \$10 Office Fee Waived for entries received by Friday, 7 PM. Make checks payable to Heritage Farm, Inc. \$25 fee on returned checks.
- Lead Line, Walk Trot, Beginner, will be held in small square ring. Schooling will be available outdoors at that time. Non-PHA beginner section begins at noon in indoor ring.
- All participants must sign the entry form which is also a release. Participants under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian sign the entry form.
- All participants must wear an approved ASTM/SEI helmet with chin strap at all times when mounted.
- Trophy and 6 ribbons for all classes. Championship and Reserve for each division with 3 or more riders. Riders must ride and be judged in all classes of the division to be eligible for championships.
- Please, NO DOGS. Parking, rest rooms, water and food available on show grounds.
